Southern District of Indiana - the Magistrates' View

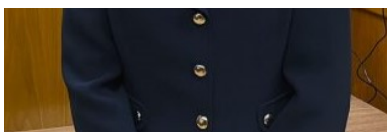
Don't miss your opportunity to meet the three most recently appointed full-time Magistrate Judges from the Southern District of Indiana with whom Labor and Employment attorneys regularly interact. These judges help us with everything from discovery disputes to mediation.



The Hon. Kellie M. Barr was appointed to Magistrate Judge in 2022. Prior to becoming a Magistrate Judge, Judge Barr served as a law clerk for the Indiana Court of Appeals (2006-2008), as a litigation and appellate associate at a law firm (2008-2010), and as a law clerk to District Judge Jane Magnus-Stinson at the United States District Court for the Southern District of Indiana (2010-2017). In 2017, she joined the legal team of Indiana's largest healthcare system, where she was promoted to positions of increasing responsibility until her appointment as a U.S. Magistrate Judge.



The Hon. M. Kendra Klump was appointed U.S. Magistrate Judge on January 6, 2023. She served as a law clerk to the Honorable Judith W. Rogers at the United States Court of Appeals for the D.C. Circuit. In September 2012, she took a position as an Assistant United States Attorney in Cleveland, Ohio, where she remained until January 2017. She then became an Assistant United States Attorney for the Southern District of Indiana. In February 2022, she became the Chief of the Southern District of Indiana's Drug Trafficking Unit where she remained until joining the Court in January 2023.



The Hon. Crystal S. Wildeman was appointed U.S. Magistrate Judge on September 1, 2023. Prior to becoming a Magistrate Judge, Judge Wildeman worked as an associate at Kahn Dees Donovan & Kahn, LLP, from 2006 through 2014. From 2014 through 2022, Judge Wildeman held a partner position with Wooden McLaughlin LLP (merged into Dinsmore & Shohl LLP). In 2022, Judge Wildeman joined Barber & Bauer, LLP, as partner, where she worked as a general civil practitioner representing businesses and individuals in litigation in a variety of areas including employment, contract, personal injury, and insurance.
